## Context questions

- 1) What are some things you remember from Hebrews regarding the danger of people drifting in their faith?

## Focus on passage

- 2) What does it mean to stir one another up to love and good works?
- 3) What is “the Day” that is drawing near?
  - a. Read 2 Timothy 3:1-7. How does this show the importance of being more alert as the Day draws near?
  - b. Why do you think meeting together (Hebrews 10:25) is a tool to fight back against the dangers of the last days as laid out in 2 Timothy 3?
- 4) What do you think encouragement means and looks like based on how it’s used in this passage?
  - a. How is it different from the way that word is often used?

## Application

- 5) What are some practical ways people can stir one another up to love and good works in the church context?
  - a. How does the responsibility to do this rest on both the leaders and the congregation?
  - b. What are opportunities for this to happen through different things at Perkinsville? (be specific)
- 6) How do these verses show us the need to be focused on others’ needs and not our own in the church?
- 7) How would you explain to someone the importance of being an active part of the church based on these verses? (think about the importance both to themselves and to others)
