Scripture passage: Romans 8:31-39

Focus on passage

- 1) Describe the elements of the Gospel you see in this passage.
- 2) Look at the legal language Paul uses. How does this help us when we think about our standing before God as Judge?
- 3) How does this passage demonstrate how central the crucifixion is to salvation?
 - a. How does this passage also show us how central the crucifixion is to our assurance of salvation?
- 4) How does this passage put the full work of salvation in God's hands?

Application

- 5) Paul asks a series of questions in this passage. What are important questions that many people ask themselves or others about life?
 - a. Do Paul's questions help with any of those life questions? If so, how?
- 6) How is this passage similar to Hebrews 11 that shows people who had faith in the midst of both victory and defeat?
- 7) Imagine someone comes to you and is questioning how God views him/her because of struggles with sin. How could you use this passage to counsel him/her? (*consider both the aspect of how God views him/her and how this passage could address struggles with sin*)
