Topic: Discipleship

- 1) What comes to mind when you hear the word discipleship?
- 2) What are the two main components of disciple-making as laid out by Jesus in Matthew 28:19-20?
 - a. How is this both simple (not complicated) but challenging?
 - b. Why is learning necessary, but not enough on its own to obey what Jesus says to do?
- 3) What is a disciple?
 - a. Can there be such a thing as a Christian who isn't a disciple?
- 4) What's the difference between saying "we need to do discipleship" and "we need to grow as disciples"?
- 5) Read Titus 2:1-8. How does this demonstrate that obeying Matthew 28:20 is a whole church effort and not only a one-on-one endeavor?
- 6) What are all the ways someone can grow as a disciple in the church and individually?
- 7) What do you think prevents Jesus' command in Matthew 28:20 from being fully carried out within the church?
- 8) Are there ways you participate in discipleship (either making disciples or growing as a disciple) that you didn't consider to be discipleship in the past, but now you understand actually are discipleship?
