Scripture passage: Exodus 2:23-4:17

- 1) Why do you think it's important to note that God remembered His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob?
- 2) Can you think of other places in Scripture where God has called someone for a task? How is this similar and different?
- 3) What are Moses' objections to God's orders?
  - a. How does God answer or counter each of Moses' objections?
- 4) What does God reveal about Himself in this passage that is new (up to this point in Scripture)?
  - a. Why is it important to note that this further revelation about God is revealed by God and not discovered by Moses?
- 5) What can we learn about the ways God works when looking at this passage?
- 6) Although God wants Moses to demonstrate His power to Pharaoh, it is very important that the message be clearly spoken. What does that tell us about the importance of the Gospel being verbally proclaimed? Where else do we see this idea in Scripture?
- 7) What causes people to push against obedience even though we have so many places in Scripture that should encourage us or counter our resistance?
