Topic: Perkinsville Church

- 1) Read Matthew 9:35-38. What does it say Jesus has been doing?
 - a. How might most of us feel after doing all of that?
 - b. How does busyness, travel, and dealing with lots of people in their problems affect most people?
 - c. What was Jesus' response as He interacted with the people?
- 2) Jesus was a man and experienced all the weaknesses and limits of any other man. How do you think Jesus was able to respond with compassion where most of us would respond with exhaustion or frustration or worse?
- 3) Who do you think Jesus has in mind for the role of laborers? (look ahead at the next passage; also think about Matthew 28:18-20)
 - a. How do Jesus' instructions show us that we have an active role to play in His disciple-making mission?
- 4) God so loved the world that He sent His Son to die. Jesus saw the crowds in their harassed and helpless state and had compassion. How can this challenge and encourage us as the crowds in Boone and in our church increase?
 - a. What are hindrances to you/us having the right response?
- 5) What are some specific ways you can love like Jesus loves and do what Jesus does in Perkinsville? (or ways you already are)
- 6) Take action now:
 - a. Go to perkinsville.org/serve and sign up for a way to help welcome and serve the crowds at Perkinsville. Or come to the August 23rd cookout and ministry fair to learn more.
 - b. Pray for the crowds who have come to Boone and that God would send out more laborers. Also pray that we would be those obedient laborers.
