- 3) In what ways have we seen God's faithfulness?
  - a. In what ways have we seen His mercy?
- 4) How have we seen Moses function as a mediator between God and man throughout the book of Exodus?
- 5) What was the significance and purpose of the Tabernacle?
- 6) What is significant about what we see in Exodus 40:34-38?
  - a. In what ways is this a fulfillment of what was lost in Genesis 3?
  - b. In what ways does it fall short from what we see at the end of Revelation?
- 7) What is different now in terms of our access to God, God's presence with us, etc. compared to where things stood at the end of Exodus?
- 8) How can reflecting on these things motivate us to share the Good News with those who are far from God?
