Scripture passage: Exodus 20:1-17

- 1) God said He was going to speak these words in the hearing of all the people (as opposed to telling only Moses like He does with the rest of the law). What significance does that give these ten commandments?
- 2) What is significant about the order of the Ten Commandments and what does this teach them?
- 3) What do the Ten Commandments teach about God and what do they teach about man?
- 4) Look carefully at the passage. Is there anything in there you have not noticed or thought about before?
- 5) Remember that the law is not just for individual people, but is for Israel as a nation (just like every country has laws). What kind of nation will Israel be if they observe these commandments?
- 6) If the Ten Commandments are foundational to the Law, how can we be not guilty of breaking God's Law even though we sin?
- 7) Why does a nation with God as their center and with God dwelling with them (as He will in the Promised Land) need laws?
- 8) How would you explain the purpose of the Ten Commandments to a new believer trying to understand the Bible?
