Scripture passage: Acts 9:2-10:33

- 1) What stands out to you in this text either as interesting, unclear, or for any other reasons?
- 2) What is God teaching Peter through the vision that he shows him. Consider what is shown and said, but also what Peter says about it.
 - a. How would this vision communicate the desired lesson to Peter.
 - b. Think about what would be involved in Simon the Tanner's profession. What might the Jewish community think of his profession and how might they think of him for having this profession?
 - i. Now think about what it means that Peter is staying in his home.
- 3) **Community question:** A miracle is performed when Tabitha is raised from the dead. How does community also play a role in her resurrection?
 - a. What does it take to have the type of community that we see in the account of Tabitha?

Catalyst Question (how can this passage direct our focus outward?)

Describe the pattern of obedience you see throughout this passage. Don't think only about where someone is directly told to do something, but even where obedience happens just in the normal patterns of life.

What unplanned results do the steps of obedience lead to?
