

# Questions To Go Deeper

## Scripture passage: Leviticus 10:1-5

*One goal of the Dazed and Confused series is to help think about how to study and understand the Bible. The questions below can be used for any passage of Scripture large or small. Try using them on this week's passage and see what insights you can gain.*

- 1) What parts of this passage are confusing or odd (be as specific as possible)?
  - a. If you haven't already done so, try to explain as best you can what makes it confusing or odd (you can't begin to search for an answer if you're not clear about the question)?
- 2) What's the context of this passage? Consider:
  - a. What has happened leading up to it?
  - b. What is happening in the book (Leviticus) to this point?
  - c. What is going on in the story of Scripture to this point? Think about:
    - i. Who are the main people involved?
    - ii. What is God trying to accomplish with and through them?
  - d. Who is the author writing to?
- 3) With the above questions in mind, what might God be trying to show to the original audience (be careful not to jump to application yet)?
- 4) Are there any other similar events or teachings in Scripture that could help with understanding this passage?
- 5) Go [blueletterbible.org](http://blueletterbible.org) or download the Blue Letter Bible app and look up words in the original language and see where and how they are used elsewhere in the Bible. Sometimes this can give extra insight.
- 6) Looking through a New Covenant lens: Are there any aspects of this passage that are either fulfilled by Jesus or paralleled in what Jesus has done?
- 7) Given everything discussed to this point, how would you:
  - a. Begin to answer the initial questions you had?
  - b. Explain to someone how we should understand this passage?
